3.2 School Performance Plan

Review of the SPP Working Goals for 2024-2025

1. Student Success Goal:

Based on MAP data from Spring 2024 *SBAC results, we seek to increase the percentage of student meeting/exceeding growth projections in Math and Reading from 50&-60% (Spring 2024 results) to 60-70% (Winter 2024) to 70-80% (Spring 2025) as measured by MAP Growth Assessments and SBAC 24-25 Scores.

Action Steps:

Teachers will collaborate during PLC's using the Assess-Plan-Teach model to design common assessments based on DRC interim assessments and quality instructions materials. Teachers will review student performance data to make changes and impact student learning including Lexia, Star tests, Fasbridge Benchmark & Progress Monitoring. Exact Path Math, Happy Numbers, Xtramath, and Envision. We are also teaching IABs and using some resources for grades 3-5 on SBAC

2. Adult Learning Goal:

During the 2023-2024 school year, 80% of PLC meetings will document teachers' backwards planning, analyzing assessments and student performance, and tracking progress toward meeting goals as measured by PLC observations.

Action Steps:

Utilize PLC Framework and improve PLC practices and structures that ensure that grade levels are backwards planning and standard in mind, analyzing assessments, student performance, and progress toward meeting goals. We will be assigning goals to PLCs and teachers will share their data through agendas. Additionally, teachers will review student assessment date in alignment with enCision, Amplify, &HMH. We are looking to do long-range planning days and enhance the structure of the PLC 40 minutes with timers.

3. Connectedness Goal:

We seek to increase the percentage of our 3rd-5th graders who feel they can improve their intelligence through growth mindset and practice from 20% to 50% by 2024, as measured by the District Wide Survey, Panorama, and school wide perception survey.

Action Steps:

Give out the survey to students (add questions about character building and/or comfort with staff/at school); Students review the coping skills strategies.

- consistency in the Sanford Harmony/RethinkEd Character lesions (15-20 min devoted to a character trait or a weekly character trait) and C.H.A.R.T.
- Counselor lesions on self-regulation & growth mindset
- MAP Goal Setting
- Working to design a personalized school-wide survey as a 3rd point of data in addition to Panorama & District-wide survey

Megan reviewed the SPP and said they are seeing success with programs and adjusting along the way. Finding time is always hard and they are trying to plan further in advance and be consistent to allow for adjustments. A suggestion was made for standardized instructions that apply from K-5 at each test to remind kids what to do if they need help (can't hear in the headphones, etc.) Teachers find it helpful for kids to have practice and understand how the programs work BEFORE testing so they are more focused on the test and less distracted by a program that is unfamiliar.

3.3 Code of Conduct Review and Feedback

Pula and Rebecca had additional feedback after further review of the Code of Conduct. The suggestion was for more clarification on the protocol and outcome for teachers if there is a false accusation. Megan will check with the CCSD to see if there is an additional document already in place for teachers and staff. Everyone agreed that kids should always be encouraged to report. But sometimes false reports are made or misunderstandings happen and teachers would like clarification on how that is handled so they receive support. Everyone should always feel safe and there is protocol in place to address situations. Overall, incidents are down from last year.
